## A SAMPLING OF LOCAL FUNDRAISING PROJECTS

**Burnt District Festival BBQ** - The Rotary Club operates a booth at the city's Living History Festival during the first weekend in October. All members are asked to work a minimum of one shift at the booth.

**Christmas Auction**- At the annual Christmas party, club members donate and participate in an auction. The proceeds from the auction are given to local charities. Past recipients include the Mayor's Christmas Tree Fund, the Shepherd's Staff Food Pantry, and the Cass County Toy Shop.

**Flag Project**- The Rotary Club offers an opportunity for local businesses to show their patriotism. For six holidays during the year, Rotary members will put up and take down an American flag at the business. The club charges a minimal fee for this service.

**Kansas City Day** - Rotary Club members sell Kansas City Star newspapers throughout the community on opening day for the Kansas City Royals. All proceeds are donated to Rotary Youth Camp.
